



# Summer Programs 2018

**Summer Dayz Day Camp-** NEW!! This summer we are giving K-1 (entering K-1 for the 2018-19 school year) their own summer camp to offer parents more options for care and give our youngest participants a better summer camp experience. The children will be engaged in a theme each week and will also embark on a field trip on Friday, but our field trips will be in closer proximity to Dillon, or even involve staying in town. All K-1 field trips will return to the Y at 4:00pm. (there is a couple exceptions to this, please see Camp Themes and Field Trips below) Children may be picked up at 4:00 or may stay for our Friday afternoon movie until 5:30pm. Each day children will be provided with a morning and afternoon snack and will have the opportunity to participate in "hot" lunch on occasion throughout the summer. A sack lunch is available daily for the campers in cooperation with Dillon Elementary School.(subject to elementary school retaining their grant) All Day Camp will run from 7:45am-5:30pm, 1/2 Day Camp will run from either 7:45am-12:45pm or 12:30pm-5:30pm. You must pick either AM or PM and stick with that time for the entire summer. 1/2 day campers are welcome to come on the Friday all day field trips.
