



## Summer Programs 2019

**Summer Adventures Day Camp**- NEW!!! A summer camp just for children going into Kindergarten for the 2019-20 school year. Smaller group sizes will give us the ability to focus on our youngest campers so they get more in depth themes and have a smaller teacher to child ratio. Our qualified and caring staff will give your child a fun summer with tons of activities, games, and projects to help boost confidence and self esteem in preparation of the upcoming school year. Children will embark on a field trip each Thursday along with our entering 1st grade campers. Buses will arrive back at the Y at 4:00pm on field trip days. You may pick your child up at 4:00 or they can stay and enjoy our Thursday afternoon movie until 5:30. Each day children will be provided with a morning and afternoon snack and will have the opportunity to participate in "hot" lunch on occasion throughout the summer. A sack lunch is available daily for the campers in cooperation with Dillon Elementary School. (District will send information and paperwork with all students) Each child enrolled for the entire summer will be eligible for one 2 week (M-W only) swim lesson free of charge. This opportunity is brought to you through a Washington Foundation Grant. Each Friday the groups will rotate through 4 different walking field trips in the afternoon. Trips and times will be sent home on the monthly calendar of events. Summer Adventures Day Camp will run from 7:45am-5:30pm for full time children or either 7:45am-12:30pm or 12:30pm-5:30pm for half day participants.

**Summer Dayz Day Camp-** This summer we are giving 1st grade (entering 1st for the 2019-20 school year) their own summer camp to offer our young participants a better summer camp experience with smaller group size. All 1st grade field trips will combine with Kindergarten and will return to the Y at 4:00pm. Each day children will be provided with a morning and afternoon snack and will have the opportunity to participate in "hot" lunch on occasion throughout the summer.
